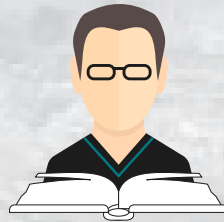

Due to the difficulty and danger of students and staff commuting because of the **occupation's checkpoints** and continuous attacks



there are hundreds of **detainees** in the West Bank and thousands of **wounded** in Gaza Strip from the higher education community, and their numbers are difficult to determine as of the time of preparing this report



The number of detainees among Palestinian university students in the West Bank reached 118, including **20** from **Palestine Ahliya University**

A workshop titled "**Economic Boycott and Its Role in Enhancing Resilience**", organized by the Student Affairs Deanship at PAU

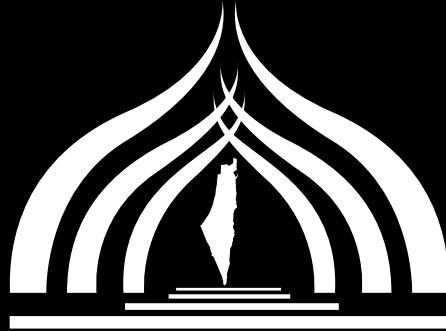
