Overview:

This policy ensures that all food and supplies purchased by the university are sourced ethically, prioritizing sustainability, fair labor practices, and environmental responsibility.

Objectives:

- 1. To promote sustainable and ethical procurement practices.

- 3. To enhance the university's commitment to social and environmental responsibility.

Scope:

This policy applies to all university departments involved in the procurement of food and supplies, including food services, event management, and general operations.

Statements:

- 1. Suppliers must adhere to fair labor standards and safe working conditions.
- 2. The university will prioritize sourcing local, organic, and ethically produced food.
